Mary Dolban asked if a surplus fund could be used to bring down the price of the semi-formal tickets.

Mr. Cini advised that no these funds need to represent the whole population of the school and not just a certain group. There is a contingency fund to help students in need that may require funds to help with a ticket purchase. No one is ever denied to attend an event because they can't afford it

Principal's Report.

Board has asked us to make report on SGF transparent so it will be posted on our website. The funds will be high as we are in collection mode. As time progresses it will go down. Registration forms for Grade 9 will take place 1st week of December. When the report is given it will show student activity fees for 2021. These should be shown separate and we can't use them till 2021.

If teachers have funds in accounts they will be required to report what the funds are going to be used for.

Upgrading items for Music Program – Teachers gave of list of what was needed. She was advised that \$14,000 will be given for replenishing.

Robotics Course – may need to spend money here in order to equip for the course.

Everyone will get help with the funds.

Question from D. Foss regarding where PIP money was going to. This money is used for PIP excursions as well as donations.

Isaac Murdock – an Indigenous speaker will be here on December 2nd to talk about residential schools. He will be here painting a mural with the Arts students. There are 4 panels of white walls and he will create a mural in this space.

Advent – instead of an advent mass each grade will be going to church on various days. The grade 12s will have an inhouse service.

December 11 and 12 – Dance Show (Grade 12s). This will part of the CPT for the senior students.

Exams and CPTs – If parents choose to go on vacation at this time their students would receive a mark of 0. It is important that parents do not plan vacations around this time as well as in June when final exams and CPTs take place.

In September there was a textile drive. 85% of used clothing ends up in a landfill. The ECO club has organized a textile drive from November 25th to December 6ths wherein used clothing is brought to your homeroom. Bags are labelled and then donated.
