### **Vice Principal Report**

### Principal's Report.

Discussion took place regarding CUPE work to rule job action. Reassured that it was only Secretarial and Janitorial workers.

Secretary not doing work that involves financial or the handling of money in any way, and any matters that required cheques to be written were done prior to action taking place. Secretaries taking breaks, and lunch together, and doing no photocopying.

Custodians are only cleaning classrooms and anything that is a Health/safety risk only and not areas that are not funded.

Library technicians will just have to wait and see what happens with Provincial Government.

All after school permits are cancelled during the work to rule.

Due to the retirement of the last Attendance Secretary Mrs. Ginn the current guidance/attendance secretary is doing double duty so it's a bit of a struggle.

Current enrollment is at 680, which is up from the projected 640. Some class sizes are larger then what is desired and in the 30 range and some as large as 36. Applied classes are larger than expected in grades 9/10 classes which has had an impact on what classes could be offered.

Wednesday October 2, 2019 Grade 8 Open house will take place. Unfortunately, Clarkson S.S has theirs on the same night.

October 10 student progress reports go home and parents should remember it's too early in the year to grade students and should be reflective of students learning styles/skills, and attendance.

October 17, 2019 Parent interviews will take place. There will be a meet and greet from 6:30pm -7:30pm and interviews will be from 7:30pm -8:30pm.

October 10 – opening Thanksgiving Mass and Father Scott will not be in attendance this year. School day will follow a modified schedule.
