


Regional Arts Program (RAP)


- Allows Iona to receive students from outside our regular boundary
- Focuses on the "holistic" development of the student artist
- Provides experiential learning and reach ahead opportunities
- Includes an overnight RAP trip every couple of years. This year we're going to NYC.
- Iona Catholic Secondary School does not provide bussing transportation to Regional Arts Program Students outside the school catchment area.
- The graduation requirements are the same for all students attending an Ontario high school
- You will be able to receive all of the prerequisite credits needed to attend any post secondary program that you choose while in the RAP program







SPECIALTY MAJOR: VISUAL ARTS










- Available at the Junior and Senior levels, to individuals of different skill levels.


VISUAL ARTS PROGRAM

- Grade 12 senior dance students choreograph and produce the annual showcase, There Is A Time, featuring the entire dance program and students who audition. This collaborative event celebrates both seasoned dancers and newcomers, highlighting creativity and talent.
- This year, dancers had the special honor of performing at Mississauga's 50th Anniversary celebration, where they welcomed the Mayor and other esteemed dignitaries.
- They also have opportunities to attend dance trips to performances by professional companies and to take workshops and master classes from visiting dance artists.

SPECIALTY MAJOR: DRAMA

- Designed for students passionate about drama, this program enhances acting, performance, and production skills while exploring key concepts across various theatrical disciplines.
