Responsibilities Include:

- Assist with program administration including the preparation, organization, and inventorying of visual art supplies
- Helping with studio set-up and clean-up
- Shadowing and assisting Artist Educators in visual or performing arts workshops for grades JK-12 in English or French
- Assist with daily customer service duties, such as greeting and guiding school groups to workshops and performances
- Office administration, including data entry, program research, preparing marketing materials, and packing school projects for pick-up
- Assisting the Studio Arts, Education & Outreach team in various program specific projects
